


Company Presentation

Our history

- FDB was founded in 1896 by Severin Jørgensen, who merged all the small cooperatives into Forenede Danske Brugsforeninger.
- In 1942 the director of FDB, Frederik Nielsen, hired the young architect Børge Mogensen as the manager of the design department, who went on to revolutionize the Danish furniture designs.
- The idea was to set up an industrial production of furniture, so it was possible to produce furniture not just for the wealthy, but for the common man.
- practical furniture of the day, with the goal being to design beautiful, functioning furniture.
- mass medias were produced and through the 50'ies and 60'ies there were eleven stores.
- grocery stores.






Timeline



1942 FDB Møbler was born and Børge Mogensen appointed as Creative Manager.

From the beginning of the 1940s, Børge
Mogensen continued Kaare Klint's approach
to furniture design based on the dimensions
of people, objects and furniture.



1944
The first collection was presented
- "By the people, for the people".




1947
The first furniture was produced in Njalsgade in Copenhagen. In 1947 FDB bought Tarm Chairs and Furniture Factory. The factory employed 50 carpenters and produced 10,000 chairs in one year.



1950's & 1960's With more than 2.000 selling points in Denmark, FDB Møbler was the biggest furniture company in Denmark



1967
The creative studio was closed, with Jørgen Bækmark as the last Creative Manager.



1980
In 1980 the factory in Tarm was sold, and the last piece of furniture was produced.
All design rights were given back to the furniture architects.



success.




2019




